

### Environmental Directives

1. Clean area daily, disposing of trash, garbage, and waste materials into dumpster.
2. Household garbage should be put directly into dumpster; barrels around the yard are for trash only.
3. Drums are provided for recycling oil and used solvents.
4. Do not leave open containers lying about that may be knocked over or run over with rain water.
5. Notify yard personnel of spillage of hazardous materials so that proper measures can be taken.
6. Minimize use of detergents in cleaning boats. Use biodegradable substitutes when possible.
7. Smoking is not allowed inside any building

**CHARGES:** (30' minimum)

Hauling & launching, round trip	4.50 per foot
Hauling & launching using 4 straps or spreader beam	5.50 per foot
Pressure washing	2.00 per foot
Blocking	2.00 per foot
Crane service with operator	150.00 per hour, ½ hour minimum

Extra cushioning or blocking to protect chine rails may incur additional costs. All per foot rates based on our measurement of your boat including bowsprit, swim platform, dingy, davits, etc.

Pressure washing does not include scraping of barnacles or extended growth. This would be billed at our rate for bottom work.

## **STORAGE:**

Do-It-Yourself, short term           \$1.00 per foot per day

Owners are not allowed to change boat blocking or stands. All subcontractors must be approved by yard manager, must have liability insurance, and must report to office before performing any work in our yard. No sandblasting or spray painting allowed by owner or subcontractors. A cleanup fee may be assessed if work area is not kept clean.

Long Term:                   \$5.00 per foot per month, 3 month minimum

All boats should carry port risk insurance. Roller furling sails and drain plugs must be removed and other sails and loose items lashed securely. Bock Marine is not responsible for maintenance checks on stored vessels unless prior arrangements are made. This includes interior flooding, mildew damage, and freeze protection.

Working and/or LiveAboard: \$10 per foot per month, 1-½ month minimum

More than 2 people living aboard a vessel will be charged an additional \$10 per day per person.

Transient Dockage: \$1.50 per foot per night

## **Additional Charges:**

All rates are subject to North Carolina sales tax (currently 7.75% on material) plus 3% environmental surcharge and administration fee. Excessive waste and environmental problems will incur extra charges.

## **Insurance and Damage Prevention:**

All boats should have hull and liability coverage. Bock Marine is not responsible for loss or damage to vessel or articles due to fire, storm, theft, winds, ice, spray painting, vandalism, or acts of God: nor for liability to owners, guests, etc. whether working or visiting the yard premises.

In the event of a severe storm, the yard will attempt to provide preparation and damage prevention service, the cost of which will be prorated over all boats. However, the owner is still responsible for taking all emergency precautions possible. Bock Marine will not assume any responsibility for said protection or damages.

## **Yard Policies**

**Welcome to our facility. We appreciate the opportunity to serve you and promise to do the best job possible. To help us, please read and adhere to the following policies.**

1. An owner or their agent must sign a contract before work will begin on any vessel. Agents who sign on behalf of an owner, as well as the owner, will be responsible for payment when the bill comes due.
2. Payment for hauling, washing, and launching as well as first month's storage is due when vessel is hauled. Storage charges will be billed in advance to your credit card and charged on or around the 25th. Bock Marine accepts VISA and Mastercard.
3. Outside contractors must have permission of yard manager before performing any work in yard. Certificates of insurance are required. Please note that we charge working storage or layday rates for subcontractors hired by boat owners.
4. Bock Marine is not responsible for any overspray or damage to your vehicle while on our premises.
5. The courtesy car can be used in 2 hour increments during working hours. We require a copy of your driver's license and ask that you gas up the vehicle according to your usage prior to returning to the yard.
6. No campers or mobile homes allowed in the parking areas.
7. Dogs must be leashed at all times and are not allowed in lounge.
8. Please see yard manager for disposal instruction of oils, thinners, solvents, antifreeze, etc.
9. Relocation of jack stands and blocks may only be performed by Bock Marine personnel.
10. No scavenging. Nothing in this yard should be collected, used, or removed without permission.
11. Customers are expected to help us maintain a safe and clean environment. If we determine that clean up is necessary, a clean up fee will be assessed to that boat.
12. All tools are to be used by Bock Marine personnel only. No tools or equipment will be loaned to customers.
